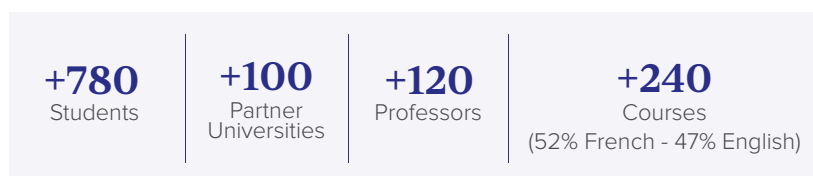

### Application Procedure

Nominated students will be contacted by the International Mobility Office to fill in an online application, and send scanned copies of the following documents to [exchange.fgses@um6p.ma](mailto:exchange.fgses@um6p.ma)

- A recent photograph;
- Copy of passport;
- Up-to-date academic transcript;
- Provisional Learning Agreement.

Once application forms are processed and reviewed, accepted incoming students will receive by July, an acceptance email together with a practical information sheet.

## Academics

- Incoming exchange students are eligible for all undergraduate and graduate level FGSES courses as long as they fulfill the required prerequisites.
- The FGSES adopts the ECTS credit scheme (1 credit=25 hours of study).
- Incoming exchange students are entitled to enroll up to 35 ECTS credits per semester. Each module listed in the course catalog (accessible at [www.fgses-um6p.ma/courselist](http://www.fgses-um6p.ma/courselist)), including the Language course offerings (Moroccan Dialect (Darija), Arabic, French, Spanish, German, and Mandarin), carries a credit value of 5 ECTS.
- Languages of instruction are English, French & Arabic.
- No official language document is required: Incoming students are recommended to have at least B2 level in English and/or French.

## On-site facilities

The FGSES/UM6P Rabat campus has modern facilities including connected-teaching blocs, library, catering, accommodation, a sport center and a swimming pool.



## Accommodation

Incoming students can opt for various options of on-campus accommodation:

**Individual room  
in a 2-bedroom flat**

2300 MAD/per month  
(≈230 USD)

**Individual room  
in a 3-bedroom flat**

1900 MAD/per month  
(≈190 USD)

**Individual room in a residence  
floor with more than 3 rooms**

1900 MAD/per month  
(≈190 USD)

\*Exchange students are assured on-campus housing, and the allocation of preferred single rooms is contingent upon availability and demand.

Nominated students will receive an email from [exchange.fgses@um6p.ma](mailto:exchange.fgses@um6p.ma) to book their accommodation in due time. Incoming students can also enjoy a relatively cheap cost of living on campus, with diverse catering offers.

## Visa & Insurance

**Health insurance:** Incoming exchange students must hold a health insurance policy meeting the following requirements:

- It must cover expenses in the event of emergency treatments and/or urgent hospitalization.
- It must cover the entire duration of your stay in Morocco.
- It must guarantee the return to your home country in case of serious illness.

International Students can arrange supplementary insurance upon arrival at the UM6P Health Center.

**Visa Application:** Incoming exchange students should apply for a study visa, depending on their country of origin.
