- Supervising undergraduate and post-graduate students,

- Playing a significant role in the design, development, and planning of courses and programs within the subject area as required,
- Serving on relevant committees,
- Attending conferences,
- Assisting the FGSES in raising funds for its Research Center,
- Maintain office hours as required by the Faculty's rules.

In addition to the above tasks, the candidate will be expected to carry out the duties of the position in accordance with FGSES policies, values and ethical standards.

**Qualifications:** The ideal candidate must hold a PHD degree in International Law or any of its subfields, as well as an outstanding track record as a teacher. He/She must also have a strong record in conducting successful research activities in their area of expertise. Finally, the candidate must be able to develop innovative approaches to learning and teaching as needed, as well as integrating technology into his/her lectures, online teaching, and using other emerging technologies.
